- This year, UUVfJ was active in defeating Measure 105 through gathering signatures for a ballot measure statement reaching every voter statewide—Oregon's thirty-year old sanctuary status was upheld!
- Our Action of the Week on the ballot measures gave guidance to many congregations.
- Our annual meeting joined our Voices with Our Children's Trust litigation on climate change, DACA youth on immigration reform, and young adults proposing state legislative changes to reduce gun violence.
- We also joined with Ecumenical Ministries to track Oregon issues.
- We're growing a presence in advocating before the state legislature and will be following specific bills in the 2019 long session from January-July.
